Dick Thomas welcomed Sarah Stubblefield, replacement for Arlington Planning Project Manager Clayton Husband, and introduced the HANA Board.

UTA Police Assistant Chief Jay Tillerson:

Dick Thomas introduced the handout "College Students Living Among Us" to the membership. Tillerson discussed the UTA code of conduct for students and protocol for reporting problems involving UTA students. UTA police have changed their patrol patterns to include resident areas around the campus. He stressed that the UTA Police Department had a strong relationship with the Arlington Police Department. Both departments want to help students understand how their actions impact others

Parks and Recreation Center Programs Manager Yvonne Flagout:

Flagout showed the membership the results of a feasibility study for combining Hugh Smith Recreation Center and East Arlington Branch Library in one facility. After community feedback, the final choice for the facility was Bob Cooke Park. The final design for the facility is not done. The anticipated opening will be Fall 2018. She reassured the group that Meadowbrook Recreation Center and Eunice Activity Center were not being closed.

Arlington Public Library Librarian David Jackson:

Jackson spoke briefly about Arlington's plans for the new Central Library. Among the issues discussed were access to the library from the parking garage, the location of the City Council Meeting Room, and the possibility of a coffee shop/book store. The plans for the library have not been finalized.

Old Town Historic District and South Center Street Historic Markers

Martha Martin invited HANA members to attend the dedication of two Landmark Preservation Commission local markers on May 24, 2015. The dedication for the Old Town Historic District Historic Marker will be at 2:00 p.m. and South Center Street Historic Marker will be at 3:00 p.m.
