Discussion of upcoming 3rd Quarter General Membership Meeting & Ice Cream Social ... arrangements, location of sign in table outside of gym across from entrance doors, food/beverages to serve, etc.

Dick Thomas reported on his casual meeting with John Hall of UTA re: a location for a possible Aldi (or other supermarket) on UTA campus property, possibly to be leased to supermarket. The site on the SE corner of Cooper and Abrams was discussed as being the appropriate size and location to meet Aldi's requirements. John Hall said that a new School of Social Work is proposed for that site.

It was discussed to set up a meeting with Devan Allen of UTA (Assistant Director of Government and Community Relations) to talk about the supermarket issue.

Discussion on designating the NW corner of Center and Pioneer Parkway as a pocket park to be owned and maintained by the city. Discussion on who to approach about. It was suggested to approach Samuel Smith III for advice on who to approach about this (letter to Council, meeting with Parks Director Lemuel Randolph, or to gather a petition of HANA members in favor of designating this area a city park or green space.)

Floreen Henry to work with South Center Street Historic District organization on rehabilitation of historic houses across from UTA on Center Street. HANA will provide a letter of endorsement for ideas generated ?
