**UT Arlington Parking:** UTA Police Assistant Chief Jay Tillerson and Director of Parking and Transportation Perry Eggleston informed the membership that UT Arlington is going to have e-registration for parking for guests/students/staff/faculty and that vehicles will no longer have stickers. Due to the change, enforcement will not start until September.

**New Arlington Central Library:**

Cary Siegfried gave a presentation on the new Central Library features with attention to the design of each floor. The new library will have a drive-through book return, rooftop garden, and access to the new City Council Chamber for events. Discussion included the Friends of the Arlington Public Library bookstore and café and the exterior design.

**Arlington Traffic:**

City Council Member Lana Wolff and City of Arlington Police Department officer Lieutenant Ross informed HANA members that, due to recorded speeding on Park Row, there will be increased surveillance on Park Row between Cooper and Center Streets.

**Arlington Dream City Sculpture:**

Bob Pruitt gave an update on the Dream sculpture that will first be in Burning Man 2015, which runs from August 30 – September 7, and then makes its way to Arlington by September 25, 2015. Downtown Arlington Management Corporation still needs \$12,000 to reach its fundraising goal for the sculpture.
